5.1 Enhancements

Library Upgrades and Security

Area: Library Upgrades and Security

Availability: Ongoing, across this and future releases

Description

A number of individual work items will be delivered across multiple releases to support the new library upgrades within Proactis S2C. Please note that the library upgrades do not affect the end user experience.

274371 – Change to System Password Policy

Area: System

Availability: Immediately

Description:

As a result of recent Security Tests, it has been suggested that the System Password policy should be strengthened. As such, the Password Length has been extended from 8 to 10 characters as a minimum. This will mean that any Users that do not comply to the new policy will be required to reset their password accordingly when logging in.

275357 – Introduce Enable/Disable Functions for Contract Management Hooks

Area: Contract Management

Availability: Immediately

As part of the new Contract Management Hooks functionality the ability to enable and disable Hooks has been introduced to Contract Management Configuration. This has been introduced as the

275359 – Include Disabled Hooks in Associating Hooks Functionality

Area: Contract Management

Availability: On Configuration

Description:

In line with the above functionality to allow Hooks to be Disabled, the functionality to associate a Contract Management Hook with Contract Templates and Contracts has been amended so that only Enabled Hooks can be associated and as such Disabled Hooks will not display in the list available to be associated.


263611 – Allow P2P Companies in SRM to be deleted

Area: SRM

Availability: Immediately

Description:

In the new SRM Configuration option for “P2P Companies”, the function to delete an entry has been made available.



Note the Delete button for each P2P Company defined in the Actions Column denoted as a Cross Symbol. Changes must be Saved to take effect by selecting the Save Toolbar button.

NOTE: Deleting a P2P Company will remove it from the P2P Company Tab in SRM and will delete the association with Suppliers.

274257 – Enforce Future End Dates Check on Contracts

Area: Contract Management

Availability: Immediate

Description:

A change to the logic when outputting Contracts from Proactis S2C to Proactis P2P (P1P2P) whereby the Contract Setting for “Output on Activation” is set to Yes on a Contract. As such, when a Contract is Activated the Contract will be checked to ensure that it has an End Date set to a future Date. If the Contract does not comply with this, it will not be activated and the user will receive an on-screen alert. The Contract cannot be activated unless the Contract End Date is set to a Future Date to comply with the rule.

5.2 Defects

The following defects have been resolved within this update:

Area	Description
Sourcing	Ref 275453: An issue was reported whereby the Scoring Panel was not displaying on-screen on an RFX Response if the Response to the question included a long single string of text (e.g. a very long URL/Web Address). This has now been resolved
